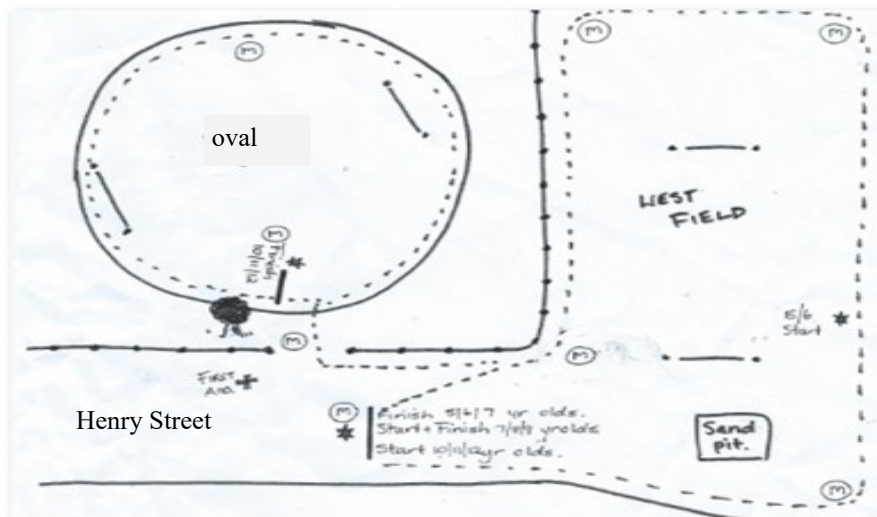
Principal's Message Term 3 Week 2
