Remote Learning

From what I have seen so far this week, the Grade 3-6 students continue to be productive and complete their required tasks. Keep up the great work and we look forward to having you all back after the long weekend.

Returning to school

Thank you for the collective effort of all families during our return. The important points still are;

- ◆ The only entry to school will be via the main gate on Henry Street.
- ◆ Students can not arrive at school until after 8.30am, unless travelling by bus.
- ◆ Students will depart school at 3.30pm, unless travelling by bus.
- ◆ Parents **MUST NOT** enter school grounds, unless they have made an appointment via the office.
- ◆ Students who are sick must stay home and seek medical advice. Any child who presents unwell will be sent home.
- ◆ ALL students must bring a labelled water bottle. No drinking taps will be used.
- ◆ We have a supply of hand sanitiser and soap placed in all learning and administration areas.
- ◆ There will be increased cleaning around the entire school.
- ◆ NO PARKING in the turning circle...it will be a continuous rotation of vehicles.

Reports

As I mentioned last week, student reports will look slightly different than previous years. The condensed version highlights the effect remote learning has had on education. Contact your child's teacher if you have any questions.

Sanitary items

The Victorian Government have committed 21 million dollars to install pad and tampon dispensers in all government primary and secondary schools. Additional cleaning and sanitising
